

**Minutes of Treffgarne Hall Committee Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2008

We will unfortunately have to wait for the Church Representative Body to come back to us.

We can't start fund raising events yet. Pat suggested putting a letter around the village explaining the delay in getting the new hall underway.

Robin suggested a letter from the PCC asking for a reply to previous correspondence. Pat will speak to the Rep Body solicitor.

Interviews have been sent to the Rep Body and we need a speedy reply.

We need a fence put up so that we can get on with the hall.

**Action:** Pat to write to the Rep Body for an update with her PCC hat on. We can't transfer the rent to the Village Hall Committee until we know what is happening with the boundaries.

It was suggested we hold a table top sale in the hall to try and raise some funds and to bring the village up to date on the situation as it is at the moment. A date to be arranged and flyers to be put around the village.
